Venue & Travel The event will take place in Comer Wood on the Dudmaston Hall estate, on the east side of the A442, 4 miles south of Bridgnorth. Access to the event will be signed from the A442. Forest entry is at: postcode WV15 6QL; longitude 52.506453, latitude -2.384862; grid reference SO 740899. The A442 is a busy and fast road, albeit that a 40mph speed restriction exists on the stretch including the access to the event. If approaching from the south, continue beyond the entrance to Dudmaston Hall for a further mile to the access road is on the right. If approaching from the north, beware the bend in the road and downhill immediately before the access road junction on the left.

Parking: Once off the A442, continue along the unmetalled road, following signs along the track beyond the new NT car park. Drive slowly! Runners may be crossing this track. Car parking is a good-sized field which should provide good standing in most conditions. Please notify organiser if bringing a minibus or coach. Registration and assembly located in the car park field.
A £1 charge will be collected upon entry to the car park, to cover landowner's fee.

Start + Finish: The Start is located adjacent to the car park field
The Finish is 300m from the car park field.

Terrain: Undulating terrain in mixed woodland, with a well developed path network. Be prepared for brambles away from the paths and tracks.
