**Venue & Travel** Titterstone Clee Hill, Shropshire, accessed from the highest point of the A4117, 500m east of Clee Hill village, between Ludlow and Cleobury Mortimer. Event signed from junction of A4117 with the Midland Quarry Products (formerly Hansons Aggregates) quarry access track, postcode SY8 3QA, at grid reference SO 595755, co-ordinates N52.375745, W-2.593604.

**Parking:** Parking in a combination of public parking areas and private quarry land, on firm compacted gravel. The quarry building, equipment and storage areas are strictly out of bounds; please keep out of all taped areas. The car parking is along side large and deep water-filled depressions; these are strictly out of bounds to all; the water is fenced and warning signs around. Please contact the organiser if bringing a coach-sized vehicle. Parking should be no more than 200 metres from the assembly area. Please note that the car parking and event areas are all very exposed to the elements.

**Terrain:** Runnable terrain, on rough open common, with plenty of fine topographical detail.  
**Map:** Pre-marked, A4, Scale 1:10k, updated 2019 by Alison Sloman.

**Courses:** White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown.  
No string course.

**Entries:** Pre-entry via <http://www.fabian4.co.uk/default.aspx?EventID=2432> from 01 September 2019(see closing dates and fees below) or EOD dependent on map availability.

**Registration:** 1000 - 1200hrs                      **Starts:** 1030 - 1230 hrs.

**Punching:** Electronic Punching using SportIdent. Please bring your SI-Card to registration for EOD only. SI-Cards may be hired for £1.00. N.B: SIAC will NOT be enabled.
