- Venue & Travel** Castlemorton Common is East of the Malverns, nearest postcode HR8 1EU, OS sheet 150 GR SO 765 381.
- Parking:** In the Malvern Hills Trust Swinyard car park. Pay and display tickets costs £4.50 per day (the MHT do check regularly). Only card payments are currently accepted.
- Terrain:** Very fast, gently sloping open area, with lots of gorse bushes and thickets.
- Map:** 1:7500 recently updated by Brian and Kay Hughes, A3 size
- Course:** 1 hour score
- Entries:** Pre-entry via Fabian4 until midnight on Thursday 17th September.

Entries limited to a maximum of 60. There will be NO entry on the day.
- Starts:** 1100 - 1228 hrs. You will be asked to choose your start time when you enter via Fabian4.
- Punching:** Electronic punching using Sportident. Note that controls will NOT be SIAC enabled. SI-cards may be hired for £1.00 (free for Juniors)
Important: please make sure that you use the **correct dibber number** when entering. We are trying to minimise contact between competitors and the SI team.
- Fees:** Pre-entry via Fabian4 to midnight Thursday 17th September

- Dogs:** Dogs welcome, please ensure they are under control at all times. Please clean up after your dog.
- Facilities:** There will be NO toilets. A first aid kit will be available
