Map:

Size, Scale(s), When updated and by whom. Pre-marked or Mastermaps. Whether protection is required or not. Any special map information.

Courses:

White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Green, Blue, Brown + String and so on.

Mention whether string is pushchair friendly.

Entries:

On the day or pre-entry - and then if pre-entry all the necessary details 1000 - 1200hrs 1030 - 1230 hrs.
