- Venue & Travel** The Amber Tavern, Hagley Road West, Birmingham B32 2AL, at the junction of the A456 and A4123.
We're meeting inside in the function area. No muddy shoes.
- Map:** Outline OOM street map 1:10,000 A4 (not waterproof, but poly pockets will be available) based on Open Street Map. oomap.co.uk
- Course:** One hour score event. Approx 25 controls, varying in points value.
One point penalty for every 6 seconds over time.
- Entries:** On the day, but please apply beforehand for a map.
- Registration:** 6.30 - 6.50 pm. **Starts:** Mass start at 7 pm.
Early/late starts can be accommodated.
- Punching:** SI race timing for start/finish only. You borrow an SI card if you don't have one. There will be questions to answer to prove you've been to the control locations. Bring a pen.
Alternatively you can punch automatically via GPS, using the MapRun app on your phone.
Ask for details.
- Fees:** Seniors £4 Juniors £1
- Facilities:** Food served till 9 pm.
- Officials:** Organiser Adrian Bailey 07505 381666
- Safety:** Competitors take part at their own risk. A headtorch (and backup torch) and hi-vis gilet are recommended. This is not a race; concentrate on the traffic - not on your map - when crossing roads. In case of bad weather competitors may be required to wear cagoules.
- Website & Cancellation:** The event will go ahead in most conditions (eg. snow) but may be cancelled if it's too icy.
