Venue & Parking: The event centre is the Portobello pub, Bransford Road, St John's, Worcester WR2 4EZ. There is a small car park behind the pub and another, larger car park the other side of Swinton Lane.

In light of coronavirus advice, registration will take place at a table outside the pub. All paperwork will be filled out by the organiser. Please bring along your own hand sanitizer.

Travel: Nearest station is Worcester Foregate Street from where the No 30 bus (at least every 30 mins before 1915) runs to within a 5min walk of the venue.

Terrain: Urban orienteering and map running with options to run along streets, unlit footpaths and unlit urban parks. Some footpaths, particularly those near streams, may be very muddy after recent flooding.

Map: A4 sized 1: 10,000 scale map on Open O map.
Control descriptions on map. Map not waterproof- bring plastic map bag if wet weather is forecast.

Course: 60 minute score, with controls taken in order worth 10, 20 or 30 points. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 1 point for each 6 seconds, or part thereof, late. Controls will be 'treasure hunt' style on monuments, signs etc and competitors will need to note down details to confirm that the control has been visited.

Entries: On the day but please reserve maps in advance (by e-mail to organiser or on the club forum) to make sure we have enough copies. However, **you must not come** to the event if you fall into one of the following categories:

- If you have a high temperature
- If you have a new continuous cough
- If you have been in Wuhan city or Hubei Province (China), Daegu or Cheongdo (Republic of Korea), Iran, or the containment areas in northern Italy on or after Saturday 7 March
- If you have been anywhere in Italy on or after Monday 9 March
- If you have been advised to stay at home by a health professional.

Registration: 18:15 - 18:55hrs **Mass Start:** 19:00 Courses close at 8:15pm

Punching: Please bring your SI-Card for timing start and finish. SI-Cards may be hired for £1.00.

Fees: Seniors £4 Juniors £2 (under 16's must be accompanied by a responsible adult)

Facilities: At event centre- please use toilet for changing.
Food available at the pub and served until 9pm. Please do not consume your own food

and drinks on the premises.
