Organiser Comments

Many thanks go to every one that supported this event, including some new faces. We were lucky with the weather and everyone enjoyed a dry run before the rain started. Several runners travelled to the event on public transport including Nathan from BOK, who made it to event via a train from Bristol and a bus from New Street station, all this in a wheelchair. Colin Palmer and Robert Vickers both had to deal with cancelled trains so it was great that they made it to the event and then home again.

I deliberately set the controls to make it unlikely that even the fastest runners would not be able to clear them. On the night, there was a close battle for first place in the men's class between Dave Aldridge and Richard Price.

Richard picked up all of the 30 point controls which was quite a feat, given their distribution. Dave's GPS showed that he ran 13km, so it's likely that Richard ran even further.

Andy White, Peter Langmaid and Robert Rose had a close tussle for third place, with Andy's better timekeeping (despite forgetting to set his watch) giving him the place.

Nathan from BOK, who was orienteering in his wheelchair, was caught out by the separate start and finish controls and had a map reading error at the start and then lost contact with the map and had a bit of a frustrating time but still covered 4.6km.

In the women's race, Eloise Lee had another fine run beating all but the two fastest men. Marian White and Mandy Mackereth had a close competition for second place with Marian's better timekeeping again paying off in a good night for the Whites.

Junior, Kieran Rose (and his dad, Peter) were first back after just over 55 minutes but still managed to visit two of the most distant controls, 30 and 32.
