Start: Leave the Scout and Guide Centre at 10:40 for walk together to start (Mass start at 11:00)

**Map:** 1:7500, 5m contours on waterproof paper updated autumn 2024 by Alison Sloman. The map will be double-sided with 15 controls on each side, odd numbers on side A, even numbers on side B, relevant control descriptions on each side. **Only one map turnover will be permitted.** Special symbol o for a sculpture. Note that hides are not shown on the map. **An orange standard course will be available, printed separately from the score maps – please request these in advance.** 

**Duration/Format:** A 60 minute score event for seniors, 45 minutes for juniors and families plus the separate orange course. On either side of the map, controls can be taken in any order but **the map may only be turned over once, so even numbers followed by odd, or vice versa.** Penalty for late return is 10 points per part of a minute late. Over 15 minutes late, all points lost.

**Facilities:** Will be available in the Scout and Guide Centre (including showers). The Scout and Guide Centre will be open from 09:30 to drop off / use toilets and we will hold the post-run social event there.

**Safety:** Competitors take part at their own risk. Whistles are optional, and bring a waterproof hooded top. The area is used by the public – cyclists, walkers, horse riders - so please respect their right to be there. No public roads are crossed but take care around the Visitor Centre car park. There will be a first aid kit at the finish.

**Control Collecting**: We will need as many control collectors as possible so that everyone can get to the social in good time. Please make yourself available if you can. **And don't forget to download!** (control collectors could pass their dibber to someone else to take to download.
