<b>Venue</b>	The much anticipated (?) return of HOC's pre-eminent night street event, the BIMM... This year hosted by The Real Ale Tavern, 67 Load Street, Bewdley DY12 2AW.
<b>Parking</b>	Dog Lane car park is a short walk from the pub. £1 per hour until 9 pm.
<b>Terrain</b>	A nice old town by the River Severn, with housing estates up the hills on either side.
<b>Map</b>	1:10,000 colour map from Open Orienteering Mapper. Not waterproof.
<b>Course</b>	A two-part score (find controls on one side of the map before turning over and finding controls on the other side) - each control is worth 20 points. Each control has a linked unmapped optional bonus control (worth 10 points). The time limit is <u>90 minutes</u> but participants may finish sooner if they wish.
<b>Entries</b>	Pre-enter by email to <a href="mailto:dadge@hotmail.com">dadge@hotmail.com</a> to reserve a map. Pay the planner (cash or card) on arrival at the pub.
<b>Starts</b>	6 pm - 7.15 pm
<b>Punching</b>	Virtual punching using MapRun 6 - download it to your device beforehand.
<b>Fees</b>	Seniors £4 Juniors (accompanied) £2
<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs welcome
<b>Food</b>	Bar snacks
