- Parking:** Event is run from Red Lion Pub Wombourne Battlefield Hill WV5 0JJ Signposted just off A449 Wombourne. Please Park in street around pub
- Travel:** Nearest rail stations at (Wolverhampton) and nearest bus stop (16/15 in Centre of Wombourne) is at ¼ mile from venue)
- Terrain:** Urban orienteering and map running with options to run along streets, and through urban parks, Wom Brook Nature Reserve, Canal and Railway Walk
- Map:** A4 sized 1:12,500 scale map on Open O map. Printed on non-waterproof paper so please bring a transparent map bag.

Controls displayed on Map
- Course & Scoring:** Using MapRun6 App which is free to download onto a smart 'phone. 60 minute score, with controls taken in any order worth 10 points each. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute, or part thereof. PIN number to unlock the course will be provided on the night. Competitors may adjust scores using HITMO function.
- Entries:** Please notify planner in advance to reserve a map richardprice88@btinternet.com. Entries £5/ adult & £2/junior. CASH ONLY. A few Spare copies will be available on the night. Please also notify planner if you are intending to eat at pub afterwards
- Start Times:** Starts 18:30 to 19:00. Persons wanting to run earlier, or who may arrive later, should notify Planner.
- Facilities:** Pub of the night is Red Lion Wombourne (1/2 Price Meals and good food)

- Safety:** Competitors take part at their own risk. Hi-vis clothing recommended at all times and headtorches should be used.
