Venue and Parking:

Sacks Of Potatoes Pub, 10 Gosta Green, Birmingham, B4 7ER. Car Park for the Pub is quite small so please if you can either park nearby or catch public transport. Note: the venue is just inside the Birmingham Clean Air Zone so please have this in mind if you have a car that doesn't meet the clean air zone requirements.

Travel:

Nearest station is at Snow Hill, but Moor Street and New Street are not much further away. Any bus that runs into the city centre will be walking distance the venue

Terrain:

Urban orienteering and map running with options to run along streets, and through urban parks. There is also a significant canal network around the aera as well. As expected with building this is also a lot of building work going on as well. I will try and plan to avoid these areas. Also expect it to be busy due to the Christmas markets on New Street (Why not make an evening of it).

Map:

A4 sized 1:7,500 scale map on Open O map. Printed on non-waterproof paper so please bring a transparent map bag.

Control descriptions on map in text format or in loose format

Course & Scoring:

Using MapRun6 App which is free to download onto a smart 'phone. 60 minute score, with controls taken in any order worth 10 points each. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute, or part thereof. PIN number to unlock the course will be provided on the night. Competitors may adjust scores using HITMO function.

**Entries:** 

Please notify planner in advance to reserve a map. Entries £5/ adult & £2/junior. Entry on day available as well but the number of maps will be limited.

Registration & Start Times:

Mass start at 6:45 and course closes at 8:15pm. Persons wanting to run earlier, or who may arrive later, should notify Planner.

Facilities:

Pub of the night is the Sacks Of Potatoes Pub where food is served to 9pm.
