Parking: Car park at Castle Hotel, 73 Worcester Rd, Droitwich WR9 8AQ

Travel: Nearest rail stations at Droitwich Spa Station (0.6km from venue) and nearest bus stop

(144 Salt Road service) is at Old Coach Road (0.3 km from venue)

Terrain: Urban orienteering and map running with options to run along streets, complex urban

pathways, urban park, canal towpath and unlit surfaced non urban paths.

Map: A4 sized 1:10,000 scale map on Open O map. Printed on non-waterproof paper so

please bring a transparent map bag.

Course & Scoring:

Using MapRun6 App which is free to download onto a smart 'phone. 60 minute score, with controls taken in any order worth 20 points each. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute, or part thereof. PIN number to unlock the course will be provided on the night. Competitors may adjust scores using HITMO

function.

Entries: Please notify planner in advance to reserve a map. Entries £5/ adult & £2/junior.

Cash only. Registration likely to be inside the pub.

Start Times: Starts from 6pm to 7pm. Persons wanting to run earlier, or who may arrive later,

should notify Planner or NSL Coordinator.

Facilities: Pub of the night is Castle Hotel Tables reservable on line until until 8:30 pm.

Otherwise, just bag a table on the night.
