Night orienteering in Worcester, Hereford, South Shropshire, Black Country and Birmingham.

Venue and Parking:

Venue for the night is The Sacks of Potatoes, 10 Gosta Green, Aston, B4 7ER. Street parking nearby (pay until 7:30pm using RingGo) and Millenium Point multi storey about 500m south of venue.

Travel:

Nearest stations are at New Street, Moor Street and Snow Hill all about  $1 \, \mathrm{km}$  to south

and west of venue.

Terrain:

Urban orienteering and map running with options to run along streets and canals, and through urban parks, exploring some of Birmingham's industrial and cultural heritage

along the way.

Map:

A4 sized 1:10,000 scale map on Open O map. Printed on non-waterproof paper so please

bring a transparent map bag.

Control descriptions on map in text format or in loose format

Course & Scoring:

Using MapRun 6 or 7 (and MapRunG on Garmin watches) which is free to download onto a smart 'phone (go to www.MapRunners.weebly.com).

Event is a 60 minute score, with controls visited in any order worth 10 points each. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute, or part thereof. PIN number to unlock the course will be provided on the night. Competitors

may adjust scores using HITMO function.

**Entries:** Please notify planner in advance to reserve a map.

Entries HOC/BOF members £6/ adult & £8 non-members. Member/non-member juniors

£3 and £4. Helpers (registration or results) £3 for BOF members.

Start Times:

Starts from 6:30pm and course closes at 8:15pm. Persons wanting to run earlier, or who

may arrive later, should notify Planner.

Facilities:

Pub/ Venue of the night is the Sacks of Potatoes where food is served to 9pm.

Notify planner if you would like to eat afterwards.
