Parking:**

**Travel:**

About ten minutes walk from Barnt Green station (note no lifts on platforms)

**Terrain:**

Urban and semi-rural orienteering and map running with options to run along streets, footpaths and country lanes. This event suits beginners and more experienced night street leaguers. A cluster of controls around the village centre which are well suited for beginners are complemented by a further wider selection on the neighbouring roads and country lanes. Hi vis clothing & torch/headtorch mandatory, there is little street lighting outside of centre area.

**Map:**

A4 sized 1:10,000 scale map on Open O map. Printed on non-waterproof paper so please bring a transparent map bag. Control descriptions in loose format

**Course &  
Scoring:**

Using MapRun6 App which is free to download onto a smart 'phone. 60 minute score, with controls taken in any order worth 10 points each. Any time over 60 minutes will be penalised at the rate of 10 points per minute, or part thereof. PIN number to unlock the course will be provided on the night. Competitors may adjust scores using HITMO function.

**Entries:**

Please notify planner in advance to reserve a map. Entries £6/ adult & £3/junior. Under 16s to be accompanied.

Start Times:**

Venue open 6.15pm. Starts from 6.30pm to 7.15pm and course closes at 8:15pm. Persons wanting to run earlier, or who may arrive later, should notify Planner.

**Facilities:**

Bar & soft drinks at Barnt Green Cricket Club.  
Food - we will make an order from Bens Lickey Hill Fish Bar for delivery c. 8/8.15. Please let us know what you would like when you reserve a map and pay on the night.
