Venue & Travel

The park is easy to get via the M5, follow signs for Country Park. It is just south of the Hospital so is well served by multiple bus routes. The nearest train stations are in the centre of Worcester, so there is approximately a 2.5 mile walk.

Registration will be by car in the north west part of the carpark.

Parking:

Plenty of free parking at the main Country Park carpark. Follow signs for the country park. WR5 2LG.

Terrain:

The Area is split into 3 parts. Nice meadows to the east with some resident friendly cattle, County Hall to the south and a compact woods, north west, with a complex path network to get the brain going.

The area would be a great intro to orienteering for a beginner.

A4 1:5000 map update June 2021 by Brian Hughes . Not Waterproof

Courses:

One course approx 6km (subject to change) . Linear score format; 1 hour time limit, 10 points per control visited, 1 point penalty for every 6 seconds over the time limit - controls must be visited in order, but you can leave some out - e.g. 1, 3, 6, 9, 18, scores 50 points, but 1, 5, 3, 9, 6 would only score 30. If confused just ask on the day, it is not as complicated as it sounds.
