(6km south of Worcester)

On Thursday 16th June 2022



Orienteering in Worcester, Hereford, South Shropshire, Black Country and Birmingham.

Venue & Travel:	SO 829487. 3km south of Powick on B4424
Parking:	Parking in Malvern Hills Trust car park on west of B4244. This car park has a barrier that may be closed at 7pm; please park in front of it. We are currently attempting to have this closure delayed. There is an additional car park 200m further south without a barrier. No fee at either car park. The start / finish area is 100m south of the northern car park - follow the hedge parallel to the road.
Terrain:	The area is a hill with open grassland on the upper parts but wooded on the surrounding slopes. The woodland, however, has many paths and rides. In places bracken and grass have recently regrown but not to the point where it impedes running and planning has taken this into account.
Map:	1:7500 with 5m contours. Not waterproof. The map was initially produced by Kay Hughes and recently updated by Brian Hughes.
Course:	One course with a 60 minute time limit. Competitors must take controls in the correct order, but may miss out controls as they wish. 10 points per control, I point lost per 6 seconds or part thereof if back late. The full course is 6km long with 225m of climb.
Entries:	Please reserve a map by sending an e-mail to <u>cpnredditch@blueyonder.co.uk</u> as soon as possible.
Registration:	Starts from 5pm - 6.30pm
Punching:	Electronic Punching using SportIdent. Please bring your SI-Card to registration. SI-Cards may be hired for £1.00, replacement fee £30 if lost
Fees:	Seniors £4 Juniors £2
Dogs:	Dogs welcome
Facilities:	No toilets. First Aid at registration.
