Venue & Travel	Saltwells Nature Reserve, Saltwells Lane, Dudley. GR SO 934869, use postcode DY5 1AX in satnav etc. Saltwells Lane is off Saltwells Road.				
Parking:	Nature Centre carpark, no charge, or on nearby public roads without causing problems to local residents. Don't park in Saltwell Inn's private carpark unless you've registered in the pub, and are intending to eat/drink there afterwards. Start and Finish close to the carpark.				
Terrain:	Partly forested former mining area. The southern part is the most mature and contains a large number of pits and depressions as well as a former claypit. Across a road to the north, Netherton Hill is more open with blocks of gorse and thickets. The summer vegetation is often unpleasant; the course has been planned to allow path-routes close to controls.				
Map:	1:7500 by Alison Sloman, updated 2021. A4 size, pre-printed but not waterproof. Clear bags will be available.				
Courses:	For the experienced, one course 5.7k with about 160m climb, 30 controls. Linear Score Format, do controls in order but omit any as you wish. 1 hour time limit, 10 points per control, 1 point penalty for each 6 seconds (or part thereof) overdue. Most controls are south of the road, but there are eight controls in the north.				
	For the newcomer or less-experienced junior, 11 selected controls give a loop of easier controls, 2.2k. This loop does not cross the road.
