Control descriptions on map and also loose. Laser printed but not waterproof- bring

plastic map bag if wet weather is forecast.

60 minute score, with controls taken in order worth 10 points. Any time over 60 minutes Courses:

will be penalised at the rate of 1 point for each 6 seconds, or part thereof, late. Controls can be missed out but any taken out of sequence will not count. For example, 1-2-3--5-6

scores 50 but 1-2-5-3-6 only scores 40 because 3 was taken out of sequence.

available for beginners, juniors and families.
