Venue & Travel

North East of Walsall just by the A542 (Chester Road), A461 (Lichfield Rd) crossroads. Several Bus routes stop on the Lichfield Road from Walsall (No. 35) and Birmingham via Kingstanding (No. 936,937,937A). Address: Andrews Road, Walsall Wood, WS9 9RL. Grid Ref - SK057039.

What 3 Words - charm.fuss.salaried.

Parking: Free parking although spaces are limited. Please share transport you can. Any restrictions on

time of arrival and departure. 2m height restriction. Possible street parking as well if the

car park is full.

Terrain: Shire oak is an old sand quarry converted to what is now a mature nature reserve. It is a

compact area with complex contours and an extensive path network.

Map: A4 1:5000 map updated November 2021 by Barry McGowen. Not waterproof.

Courses: One course approx 5.8km. Linear score format; 1 hour time limit, 10 points per control

visited, 1 point penalty for every 6 seconds over the time limit - controls must be visited in order, but you can leave some out - e.g. 1, 3, 6, 9, 18, scores 50 points, but 1, 5, 3, 9, 6 would only score 30. Note that the map will have a map exchange meaning it will be

double sided.
