OS Map 139, Ref SO948810 on Uffmoor Lane, 0.8k south of the A456. The A456 is a dual carriageway, so the north end of Uffmoor Lane can only be accessed from the east.

Parking:

Early arrivals can use the public carpark, B62 ONF, 2m height restriction. **This carpark will be locked at 8pm.** There is parking on the east side of Uffmoor Lane, just to the south of the public carpark. Registration will be from the Planner's car, on Uffmoor Lane. **Those who arrive/start after 6.30pm MUST park on the road.**

Terrain:

Uffmoor Wood slopes gently to the north, and is dissected by several streams, which have carved shallow valley systems. There are many ditches, some point features, and a good path network. There is some bramble at the edges of open rides, but the woods are surprisingly runnable. After wet weather the banks of the streams can be very slippery.

Map:

A4, 1:7500 with 5m contours, updated Summer 2021 by Alison Sloman. Not waterproof.

Courses:

One course, approx. 5k with 100m climb.. Linear Score format: 1 hour time limit, 10 points per control. 1 point penalty for every 6 secs overdue. Controls must be visited in order, but controls may be left out. Eg Controls 1, 2, 5, 7, 15 would score 50.

No toilets. First Aid Kit.
