Parking:

Small public car park. No charge. Overflow parking at SO804776 DY11 5RD – do NOT park on the access

drive or passing places thereof.

Terrain:

Valley with a mixture of woods and open land. Some steep slopes and sandstone crags. Start and Finish

by car park.

Map:

1:5000 on A4, latest update 2021 by David Williams. NOT waterproof – transparent pockets available or

bring your own map bag.

Courses:

One linear score course with 60 minute time limit – do the controls in order, but you can miss out controls or sections, e.g. 1-2-4-5-8-10. Controls 10 points each; finishes over the time limit will be penalised 1 point per 6 seconds over. Some easier controls for less experienced and/or physically

challenged night-Oers will be included.
