Parking:

Parking is at the above address and is Free.

Terrain:

Eastern half is open marshy moorland terrain. The course will hopefully avoid the wettest parts. Western half is a mixture of wood typical with some pine and holly brushes more typical with the main part of Sutton Park. Map area is quite flat which explains the long course length.

A4 Size, Scale 1:7500 (from 1:10000 especially for this event), updated by Alison Sloman in

Jan 2024. Not-Waterproof so please being map bags if you have them.

Courses

One course (6.9km) and a 60-minute time limit. Competitors must take controls in the correct order but can miss out controls as they wish. 10 points per control. 10 points lost each minute late and 1 point every 6 seconds. For example, 1,3,5,6,8 will score 50 points but 3,2,5,7,1 will only score 30 points. No competitors should be more than 75mins.
