**Organiser Comments**

Many thanks go to every one that supported this event, including some visitors and new hands at night orienteering in terrain rather than in the street league. We were lucky with the weather after weeks of rain, but conditions underfoot were muddy and slippery. Storm Darragh had wreaked a lot of damage to the woods with dozens of mature trees being blown over or even snapped off. While this will provide a lot of new 'rootstock' control sites it created difficult conditions on some paths. However, the worst damage was the area in which the council used contractors to fell some diseased ash trees. The contractors machinery has flattened a large area that I tried to re-map before deciding that it just wasn't an area that was safe to traverse in the day, let alone at night. Hopefully the restoration and replanting programme promised by the council will restore this area.

The women's race was won by Mandy Mackreath, followed by Sammy Pritchard, who could perhaps have picked up another couple of controls on the way back from 10. Helen Clare, running in her first night event, picked up a very creditable nine controls but went a couple of minutes overtime as a result.

The men's race was a close affair with Chris McCartney picking up 20 of the 23 controls, closely followed by David Williams, Dave Aldridge and Ben Crone who all picked up 19 controls.

Many thanks to control collectors, Andy Hemsted, Kerstin Mitchell, Ben Crone, Dave Williams and Karl Kingsman. Andy volunteered to go and pick up a second pair of controls that were gripped and Karl managed to find a control that had escaped the collectors while out for a walk in the woods the following day.

There was a bit of a scramble to get all of the kit into Andy's car so we could get to the pub in time for last food orders where we had a very economical supper courtesy of Kerstin's 40% off voucher.
