## **Organiser Comments**

Storm Darragh had wreaked a lot of damage to the woods with dozens of mature trees being blown over or even snapped off. While this will provide a lot of new 'rootstock' control sites it created difficult conditions on some paths. However, the worst damage was the area in which the council used contractors to fell some diseased ash trees. The contractors machinery has flattened a large area that I tried to re-map before deciding that it just wasn't an area that was safe to traverse in the day, let alone at night. Hopefully the restoration and replanting programme promised by the council will restore this area.

The women's race was won by Mandy Mackreath, followed by Sammy Pritchard, who could perhaps have picked up another couple of controls on the way back from 10. Helen Clare, running in her first night event, picked up a very creditable nine controls but went a couple of minutes overtime as a result.
