Orienteering in Worcester, Hereford, South Shropshire, Black Country and Birmingham.

Assembly and Download will be in the northern car park of Malvern Link Common on Cockshot Venue:

Road WR14 2TZ OS Grid ref SO780472. The start, finish and assembly area are all very close

to Malvern Link Railway station. Please consider travelling by train to the event.

There is only limited car parking so please share transport or travel by train if possible. Parking:

There are 2 small car parks on Cockshot Road. The smaller northern Cockshot Road car park will be used by event officials. The larger southern car park on Cockshot Road has space for around 24 cars. Once these are full, cars will be directed to nearby roads and the public car parks at Victoria Park on Pickersleigh Avenue WR14 2LJ and Newtown Road WR14 1PD. No parking allowed on Malvern Link Common apart from on the designated car parks.

Mainly urban with some parkland areas. Some climb on longer courses. Terrain:

Safety: All courses run over Malvern Link Common which can be wet and slippery after rainfall. Take

care when crossing any roads. Junior course competitors will encounter areas where there may be limited low speed vehicle movements. Competitors need to be aware of other road users and that roads have not been closed for this event. Competitors take part at their own risk. Whistles are recommended. Training shoes which have a good grip are probably the most suitable footwear. In case of bad weather competitors may be required to wear water- and wind-proof tops (aka cagoules).
